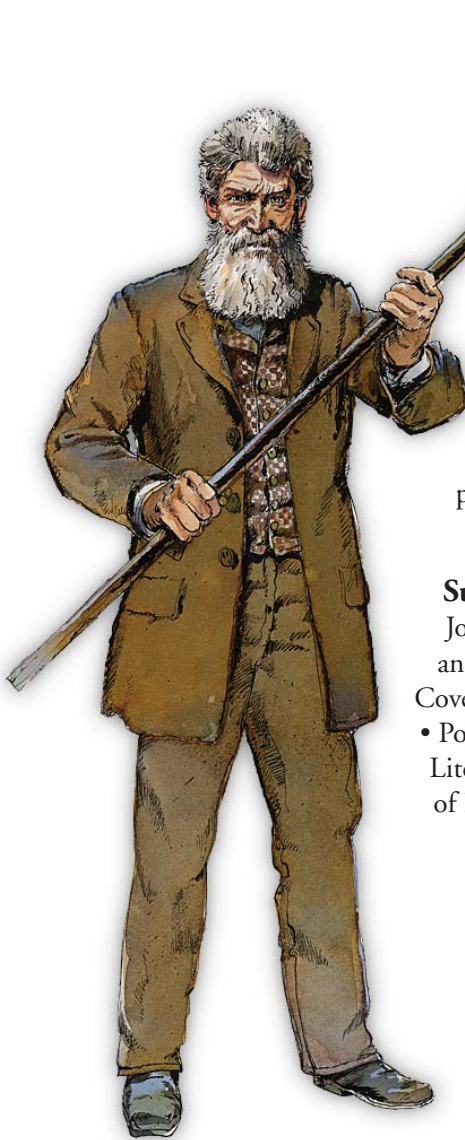

Harpers Ferry National Historical Park, along with other partners, will host a multidisciplinary academic symposium on John Brown and his 1859 raid on Harpers Ferry. This early announcement of the conference is designed to stimulate new and innovative scholarly research and debate. We welcome 300 word abstracts or proposals. Proposals for panels are also welcome. All presentations will be eligible for submission to the proposed publication of the conference's juried proceedings.
